- Interesting off-road race, multi-terrain course of approx. 7 miles, running through delightful undulating South Staffordshire countryside– all miles marked .
- 793 entered in 2010
- Start & finish on /near Pattingham Village Hall Playing Fields
- The off-road course is clearly sign posted and well marshalled.
- The race will be held under UKA rules and an official Cross Country Race permit obtained from the Midlands County Athletics Association. Third party /Public Liability Insurance is provided by the UKA insurers.
- Drinks & medical support en route and at the finish.
- Adequate off-road parking nearby.
- Limited changing facilities with toilets but no showers.
- Participants are expected to 'run' the race and not 'walk'.
- Dogs are not allowed on the playing field or Patshull Estate
 - if you can leave your dog at home it would be appreciated.
- **Prizes: First 3 men and first 3 ladies**
 - Male veterans (30+/40+/50+/60+)**
 - Female veterans (30+/40+/50+/60+)**
 - First runner from Parish of Pattingham with Patshull receives Cup. **(held for one year)**
- **Commemorative horse brass for everyone as they go through the finish.** (Please enter early to help us gauge the number of brasses required.)
- Relax/collapse at the finish with a hot or cold drink and a delicious piece of home made Harvest Fruit Cake.
- After donations have been made to local charities (such as The County Air Ambulance) all proceeds from the race will go to St Chad's Church Pattingham.
