SCARECROW REGISTRATION

The ultimate aim of the Scarecrow Festival is to involve the village in a community event that is great fun for all, whilst at the same time raises funds for St. Chad's Church.

We envisage a marked trail around the village where the scarecrows are displayed in front gardens - looking over walls or whatever - but all visible from the road/pavement. We know that the trail will start from the Church, but the rest of the route cannot be determined yet until we know the numbers of scarecrows being made and their location. Just because you do not live right in the centre of the village does not prevent you from joining in the fun, we have numerous sites that require "scarecrows" which we hope will be filled by entries made by people living a little further afield.

We invite anyone who wishes to to create a scarecrow, or tableau of scarecrows, based on any character or theme of their choice.

However to achieve all this we do need to know well in advance if you plan to join in and make a scarecrow, so please take a Registration Form and return it BEFORE JULY 30th.
